
In re: Electronic Filing of Proposed Orders

GENERAL ORDER NO. 3:07-10

This Court's Electronic Filing Policies and Procedures Manual provides at § E.2.d that "A proposed order should be attached to an Internet e-mail sent to the e-mail address of the assigned judge."

Effective immediately, the term "assigned judge" means the District Judge to whom the case is assigned and any Magistrate Judge to whom the case has been referred. Proposed orders should be sent by email to every assigned judge in the case, except that proposed orders in private foreclosure actions should be sent only to the assigned magistrate judge.


