Upon advice that the current term of United States Magistrate Judge Terence P. Kemp will expire on September 17, 2011 and upon determination that such Magistrate Judge be reappointed for a term of eight (8) years, the court does determine to proceed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 631, and the regulations of the Judicial Conference promulgated under authority of 28 U.S.C. § 631 (b) (5).

Such panel reviewed Magistrate Judge Kemp's performance in office as a Magistrate Judge and considered all comments received from members of the bar and public. Such panel reported to this Court and recommended that Magistrate Judge Kemp be reappointed.

Accordingly, United States Magistrate Judge Kemp is hereby reappointed as a full-time United States Magistrate Judge at the salary fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States with his official duty station being designated in Columbus, Ohio.


Said United States Magistrate Judge shall enter upon the performance of his duties at 12:01 a.m. on September 18, 2011 but prior to the commencement of such duties, he shall take the oath of affirmation prescribed by 28 U.S.C. § 453 and § 631(g).

Terence P. Kemp, United States Magistrate Judge, is to hold and discharge the duties of his office for a term of eight (8) years from the date of his appointment subject to the provision of 28 U.S.C.A. § 631 (c), unless sooner removed.

The Clerk of this Court is directed to file certified copies of this Order in the records of each division of this Court and shall likewise forward a certified copy of this Order to the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts.
