


GENERAL ORDER


Pursuant to authority reserved to the local building security committees in S.D. Ohio Civ. R. 83.2(e), attorneys may enter the United States Courthouse and Federal Building at 200 West Second Street, Dayton, Ohio, with their cellphones, even if those devices include cameras. Persons recognized by the Court Security Officers as attorneys at law need not provide proof of bar admission, but such proof may be required of anyone else seeking to enter with a cellphone/camera. This Order does not create permission to operate a camera as prohibited by S.D. Ohio Civ. R. 83.2(a).




