**PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 36**

**June 11, 2015 Conference Order**

This matter came before the Court for an in-person status conference on June 11, 2015.

This Order memorializes the results of the conference as follows:

Initially the Court addressed the selection of the plaintiffs whose cases will be tried as the third and fourth trials in this MDL. The parties informed the Court that they believe they can come to agreement on the issue within the next few weeks. The parties shall report their selection to the Court at that time.

Next, the parties discussed issues related to deadlines established in Case Management Order No. 9 (“CMO 9”). The Plaintiffs’ Steering Committee (“PSC”) requested exemption from the June 12, 2015 deadlines established in CMO 9. Specifically, the PSC asked for additional time to provide a list of exhibits that were cited by or testified to by DuPont’s experts. The Court granted the PSC’s request. The parties agreed to work together to resolve the issues related to this group of exhibits. This issue will be addressed again at the next in-person status conference.


The Court next addressed the issue of *Lexicon* waivers. The parties offered to discuss the issue and report back to the Court in approximately two weeks.

Finally, the Court set the next in-person status conference for July 22, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. in Room 301 of the United States District Court, Joseph P. Kinneary United States Courthouse. As set forth in the Court's April 12, 2013 Order (ECF No. 2), the parties must confer prior to the conferences and file with the Court, no later than two business days prior to the conference, an agenda of issues to be addressed. If any of those issues relate to proposed orders or other documents the parties plan to discuss with the Court during the conference, those proposed orders or other documents should be submitted with the agenda.
