PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 20
Pro Hac Vice Requirements

This matter having come before the Court at the in-person status conference on October 23, 2013, it is hereby ordered as follows:

1. *Admission of Counsel:* Attorneys admitted to practice and in good standing in any United States District Court are hereby admitted *pro hac vice* in this multidistrict litigation without the need for a formal *pro hac vice* application. Association of local counsel is not required.

2. *Local Rules:* Each attorney admitted *pro hac vice* pursuant to this order agrees to abide by the local rules of this Court, including ethics and professionalism standards, and to be subject to the jurisdiction of this Court for all issues related to this matter, including ethics, professionalism and disciplinary matters.

3. *Pro Hac Vice Fees for Cases Filed in the Southern District of Ohio:* For out-of-state counsel who file cases directly in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Ohio as part of MDL 2433, counsel will be required to pay one *pro hac vice* filing fee regardless of the number of cases he or she files.

4. *Pro Hac Vice Fees for Cases Transferred into the Southern District of Ohio:* For out-of-state counsel whose cases are transferred into the Southern District of Ohio as part of MDL-2433, counsel will not be required to pay any *pro hac vice* application fees.
