PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 29

November 13, 2014 Conference Order

This matter came before the Court for an in-person status conference on November 13, 2014. This Order memorializes the results of the conference as follows:

Initially the parties requested an extension of time to file expert reports, *Daubert* motions, and summary judgment motions. The Court shall permit the requested extensions and hereby modifies Pretrial Order No. 27, which modified Pretrial Order No. 7, as follows:

Plaintiffs' expert designations are due December 8, 2014;
Defendant's expert designations are due January 29, 2015;
Plaintiffs' rebuttal designations are due February 12, 2015;
Expert depositions to be complete by April 2, 2015; and
Daubert Motions and Motions for Summary Judgment to be filed by April 6, 2015.

The parties also addressed Plaintiffs' Motion to Amend Complaint and Substitute Party. (ECF No. 1405.) The parties shall discuss this motion with mediator Frank Ray in an attempt to resolve the issue without judicial intervention, in accordance with the provisions of Case Management Order No. 8, (ECF No. 1297). Thus, the time for DuPont to respond to Plaintiffs'

Motion is hereby **STAYED**. The parties are **DIRECTED** to contact the Court when the matter is either resolved or the parties have reached impasse.

The Court next informed the parties of its intention to establish an MDL webpage to facilitate access by the public and the parties to information about the MDL. The Court sent the parties the link to the webpage staging site for their review. The Court will accept comment from the parties until Friday, November 21, 2014.


Finally, the Court set the next in-person status conference for December 17, 2014, at 1:30 p.m. in Room 301 of the United States District Court, Joseph P. Kinneary United States Courthouse. As set forth in the Court's April 12, 2013 Order (ECF No. 2), the parties must confer prior to the conferences and file with the Court, no later than two business days prior to the conference, an agenda of issues to be addressed. If any of those issues relate to proposed orders or other documents the parties plan to discuss with the Court during the conference, those proposed orders or other documents should be submitted with the agenda.
