## **ORDER**

It appearing to the court that on December 23, 2024, an order was entered in this proceeding directing Respondent to show cause within 30 days why this Court should not impose identical discipline as heretofore imposed by the Supreme Court of Ohio; and that notice was mailed to the Respondent at Respondent's last known address, by certified mail, and posted to this Court's official website. A response to the show cause order has been filed with the Clerk of this Court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that pursuant to Rule II of the Model Federal Rules of Disciplinary Enforcement adopted by this Court on February 1, 1979, Respondent is suspended from the practice of law in Ohio for one year, with the entire suspension stayed in its entirety on the condition that Respondent refrain from further misconduct.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Respondent fails to comply with the conditions of the stay, the stay will be lifted, and Respondent will serve the entire one-year suspension.
