ORDER

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that on April 10, 2026, an order was entered in this proceeding directing Respondent to show cause within 30 days why this Court should not impose identical discipline as heretofore imposed by the Supreme Court of Ohio; and that notice was mailed to the Respondent at Respondent's last known address, by certified mail, and posted to this Court's official website. No response has been filed with the Clerk of this Court.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that pursuant to Rule II of the Model Federal Rules of Disciplinary Enforcement adopted by this Court on February 1, 1979, Respondent is suspended from the practice of law in Ohio for one year, with the entire suspension stayed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Respondent fails to comply with the conditions of the stay, the stay will be revoked, and Respondent will serve the full one-year suspension.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of this court publish this order to the Court's official website.
