**PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 6: ORDER MEMORIALIZING APRIL 8, 2016 TELEPHONE
CONFERENCE**

The Court held a telephone conference in this matter on April 8, 2016. This Order memorializes the results of the conference as follows:

The parties have finalized terms of a stipulated ESI and Document Production Protocol, which was filed on the docket on April 5, 2016.

The parties have completed initial document productions.


Defendant will file a responsive pleading by April 18, 2016.

Plaintiffs are reviewing the documents produced by Defendant and will request further documentation if Plaintiffs believes further information is necessary prior to the commencement of settlement negotiations. Defendant intends to inspect certain of Plaintiffs' vehicles prior to the commencement of settlement negotiations, and the parties are working on a mutually agreeable process for such inspections.

The Court has been notified of a potential tag-along case, *Kogan v. Am. Honda Motor Co.*, filed in the Eastern District of New York.

The next status conference will take place on **MONDAY, MAY 2, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. EST** via telephone. The parties shall email a list of participants and their email addresses to the Court at Watson_chambers@ohsd.uscourts.gov. The Court will issue via email the conference call-in information. As set forth in the Court's October 19, 2015 Case Management Order, the parties are **DIRECTED** to confer prior to the status conference and file with the Court, no later than two business days prior to the conference, a joint agenda of issues to be addressed. Additionally, the Court directs the parties to confer regarding the potential for settlement prior to every status conference and to be prepared to update the Court as to the status of settlement negotiations at the time of each status conference.
