

Summary of changes to the 2016 CM/ECF Procedures Guide

Section 1.2.	Updated to become consistent with the practices with regards to CM/ECF Registration.
Section 1.2.	Emphasis on the difference between a CM/ECF Account and a PACER Account.
Section 1.2 and 1.3.	Updated areas which previously included only filing and responsibilities of attorneys to now include pro se filers when they have been given filing rights.
Section 1.3.2.	Updating certificate of service information to comply with the December 2018 changes to Fed. R. Civ. P. 5.
Section 2.1.	Attorneys are required to file new miscellaneous cases electronically.
Section 2.4.	Clarification that proposed orders should be emailed to chambers or attached to the motion.
Section 2.4.	Stipulations requiring Judicial Officer's signature should be submitted to chambers and not filed.
