**CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 25**

**September 28, 2018 Conference**

**Initial Scheduling of Post-Settlement Cases**

This matter came before the Court for an in-person status conference on September 28, 2018. This Order memorializes the results of that conference as follows:

The Plaintiffs' Steering Committee reported that the global settlement is nearly complete. The Defendant informed the Court that it has worked with the Clerk's Office to determine an efficient way to dismiss the 3500-plus cases that were part of the global settlement. It will provide notice to the Clerk's Office as soon as practicable as to when the dismissals will be filed so that the Clerk's Office can be staffed appropriately to effectuate the dismissals.

The Court next discussed the management plan for the approximately 32 newly-filed, post-settlement cases. The parties both expressed their sincere desire to move the cases to resolution quickly. With that in mind, the Court set the following schedule that shall be completed by the next Case Management Conference ("CMC"):

- The parties will each choose four cases that will be the first cases scheduled for trial. The parties shall provide the names of the cases to each other and the Court in the proposed agenda for the next CMC.
- The parties shall provide to the Court with the proposed agenda for the next CMC a joint proposed schedule for discovery and briefing of dispositive motions for the eight trial track cases. The Court will issue its own standing order for the trial of each case.
- The parties shall provide to the Court with the proposed agenda for the next CMC a joint proposed schedule for discovery and briefing of the cases other than the eight trial track cases.

The next in person status conference is now scheduled for **November 2, 2018 at 1:30 p.m.** As set forth in PTO 1, the parties must confer prior to the status conference and send to the Court, no later than two business days prior to the conference, an agenda of issues to be addressed. If any of those issues relate to proposed orders or other documents the parties plan to discuss with the Court during the conference, those proposed orders or other documents should be submitted with the agenda.
