**ORDER**

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Clerk of this court issue certified copies of this order to the Disciplinary Counsel of the Supreme Court of Ohio, the Clerks of the Supreme Court of the United States and the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit, the National Discipline Data Bank, and to the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Ohio, and to publish this order to the Court's official website.
