GENERAL ORDER NO. 12-02



Whereas this Court has established or is establishing a specialized supervised-release court in each of the District's three cities, namely, the START program in Columbus and reentry courts in Cincinnati and Dayton, it is hereby ordered that the copying of information contained in the presentence reports of prospective or selected participants in those three courts, as well as the disclosure of such information to the members [judicial officers] of those courts for their use solely with respect to the conduct of those courts, is authorized within the meaning of Local Criminal Rule 32.1(k).
