

The Committee on Court Administration and Case Management of the Judicial Conference of the United States has recommended that due to significant privacy concerns in social security cases federal courts should refer to claimants only by their first names and last initials. In light of these concerns, any opinion, order, judgment or other disposition in social security cases in the Southern District of Ohio shall refer to claimants only by their first names and last initials.
