Held in the Southern District of Ohio**

ORDER RESCINDING : **GENERAL ORDER 22-12**
GENERAL ORDER 20-30 :

On October 22, 2020, this Court entered General Order 20-30, an Order of Partial Sequestration pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1871(e), which instructed that jurors in jury trials or grand jury sessions are to be “kept together and not to separate” for their safety and security during the time that they are at the courthouse. The Order permitted the Court to procure meals for said semi-sequestered jurors and charge the costs of the juror meals and the delivery fee to juror fee appropriation. Due to changed circumstances, including a lessening of restrictions by the Ohio Department of Health, and as part of the gradual resumption of normal procedures in the Southern District of Ohio, General Order 20-30 is hereby rescinded. From the date of this Order forward, juror lunches will no longer be provided, except, as before, when jurors are deliberating pursuant to the *Guide to Judiciary Policy*, Vol. 4, § 365.60.20(a)(1).

IT IS SO ORDERED.
