Pursuant to the *Guide to Judiciary Policy*, Volume 13, Paragraph 825.15.15, the Court is permitted to set up accounts in the Court's financial system and accept payments prior to sentencing. Paragraph § 825.15.15 states: "If a defendant wishes to make a payment towards a special assessment, restitution, or fine, before sentencing, the clerk's office must receipt the payment only on order of the court."

Therefore, this General Order shall serve as the "Order of the Court" prior to the filing of the Judgment and Commitment Order which shall permit the Clerk's Office to accept such payments.
