**MOTIONS IN LIMINE ORDER NO. 7**

**May 6, 2016, Hearing on Motions in Limine**

This matter came before the Court on May 6, 2016, for an in person hearing on the parties' fifty-three (53) motions *in limine*. (ECF Nos. 4402–37, 4439–56.) Upon consideration of the parties' briefs and their arguments presented at the hearing the Court concluded as follows:

1. The motions *in limine* found at ECF Nos. 4402–29, 4431–32, 4435–39, 4440–56 were **GRANTED, DENIED, GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART, AND FOUND MOOT** in accordance with the conclusions made by the Court on the record at the hearing.
2. The Court will issue separate decisions on the issues of testimony related to the Ohio River, Mr. Freeman's prior conduct, and the scope of the testimony of Kelli Anne Cawley, M.D.

These issues are addressed in Plaintiffs' Motions *in Limine* Nos. 14, 17, and 18. (ECF Nos. 4430, 4433, 4434.)
