PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 32

**February 26, 2015 Conference Order**

This matter came before the Court for an in-person status conference on February 26, 2015. This Order memorializes the results of the conference as follows:

The parties informed the Court that additional time would be needed to complete the proposed initial pretrial order, currently due on February 27, 2015. (CMO No. 7 at 4; ECF No. 602.) The parties agreed that a two-week extension would be sufficient, which this Court subsequently granted. Accordingly, the proposed initial pretrial order is now due on March 13, 2015.

The parties next informed the Court that all of the expert depositions have now been scheduled. The final expert deposition is set to be completed by April 16, 2015. The parties stated that the completion of the expert depositions will not push back any previously set deadlines regarding motions for summary judgment or *Daubert* motions. Additionally, the Court acknowledged that, due to the timing of the expert depositions, there may be a need to supplement a motion with one of the expert depositions after that motion has been filed.

The Court informed the parties that the pending motions that have been fully briefed are currently under advisement.


Next, the parties and the Court discussed the plaintiffs for trials three, four, five, six, seven, and eight. Trials three and four have been agreed upon by the parties. Trials five and six will be selected from the original pool. And trials seven and eight will be thyroid cases. The parties and the Court agreed that they would select trial dates for trials seven and eight at the next in-person status conference.


The Court addressed the parties' pending motions to seal. The parties informed the Court that they would confer on the subject of those motions, and will apprise the Court of the status of the motions to seal at the next in-person status conference.

Finally, the Court set the next in-person status conference for March 25, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. in Room 301 of the United States District Court, Joseph P. Kinneary United States Courthouse. As set forth in the Court's April 12, 2013 Order (ECF No. 2), the parties must confer prior to the conferences and file with the Court, no later than two business days prior to the conference, an agenda of issues to be addressed. If any of those issues relate to proposed orders or other documents the parties plan to discuss with the Court during the conference, those proposed orders or other documents should be submitted with the agenda.
