Such panel reviewed Magistrate Judge Newman's performance in office as a Magistrate Judge and considered all comments received from members of the bar and public. Such panel reported to this court and recommended Magistrate Judge Newman be reappointed.

Accordingly, Magistrate Judge Newman is hereby reappointed as a full-time Magistrate Judge at the salary fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States with his official duty station being designated in Dayton, Ohio.

Said United States Magistrate Judge shall enter upon the performance of his duties at 12:01 a.m. on July 25, 2019, but prior to the commencement of such duties, he shall take the oath of affirmation prescribed by 28 U.S.C. § 453 and § 631(b).

Michael J. Newman, United States Magistrate Judge is to hold and discharge the duties of his office for a term of eight (8) years from the date of his appointment subject to the provisions of 28 U.S.C.A. § 631(c), unless sooner removed.
