THIRD AMENDED CIRCUIT GENERAL ORDER NO.  
THIRD AMENDED SOUTHERN DISTRICT OF OHIO GENERAL ORDER NO. 05-05


In addition to those persons listed in Paragraph 3 as exempt from security screening, the following shall be added as exempt from screening in the Potter Stewart U.S. Courthouse:

1. The U.S. Attorney and Assistant U.S. Attorneys, upon showing of official credentials.
2. The Federal Public Defender and Assistant Public Defenders upon showing of government identification.
3. The GSA staff permanently assigned within the Potter Stewart U.S. Courthouse upon the showing of government identification.

All other provisions of the General Order shall remain in full force.
