**PRETRIAL ORDER NO. 34
Filing Under Seal**

This matter is before the Court on its own motion. Based upon the nature of this MDL, the parties' representations, and the numerous under seal filings already made, the Court hereby modifies the procedures set forth in Local Civil Rule 79.3 for filing documents or parts of documents under seal. The parties shall henceforth follow these procedures to file documents under seal:

1. The parties must file a motion with the Court requesting permission to file under seal.
2. Once permission is granted the parties may electronically file documents under seal via the CM/ECF system. This may be accomplished in CM/ECF by selecting the filing events "Sealed Document" and/or "Sealed Motion." The parties should file a complete un-redacted copy of the document or motion under seal so that the Court has the entire document or motion in its complete form.
3. The parties should then file a redacted document or motion on the public docket. This may be accomplished in the CM/ECF system by selecting the filing event "Redacted Document."

Utilizing the procedure above will permit the parties to file documents and motions under seal and to view these filings as well. Thus, service will be accomplished on sealed documents and motions in the same manner as regular CM/ECF filings.

The Court cautions the parties that any documents filed under seal via the CM/ECF system without first obtaining leave of Court will be stricken. Further, the parties must anticipate the need for filing under seal and make their requests for permission so that any motion or document will be timely filed.
